TOWNSHIP OF LAWRENCE PLANNING BOARD

RESOLUTION 16-25 APPROVING AND ADOPTING A HOUSING ELEMENT AND FAIR SHARE PLAN TO SATISFY THE TOWNSHIP'S <u>FOURTH ROUND</u> AFFORDABLE HOUSING OBLIGATION

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2024, Governor Murphy signed into law P.L.2024, c.2, establishing a new framework for determining and enforcing municipalities' affordable housing obligations under the New Jersey Supreme Court's <u>Mount Laurel</u> doctrine and the New Jersey Fair Housing Act (the "FHA") (<u>N.J.S.A.</u> 52:27D-301, *et al.*); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 52:27D-304.1(f)(1)(b), each municipality was to adopt a binding resolution no later than January 31, 2025, determining its present and prospective fair share obligation for the Fourth Round of Affordable Housing Obligations ("Fourth Round"); and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of Lawrence Township ("Township") adopted Resolution No. 73-25 on January 21, 2025, identifying its present and prospective fair share obligations for the Fourth Round as follows:

Present Need:68Prospective Need:320

WHEREAS, in accordance with the FHA and Administrative Directive #14-24, issued by the Administrative Office of the Courts on December 13, 2024 ("Directive #14-24"), the Township filed a Complaint for Declaratory Judgment ("DJ Action"), In the Matter of the Declaratory Judgment Action of Lawrence Township, Mercer County Pursuant to P.L. 2024, Chapter 2, Docket No. MER-L-158-25 on January 23, 2025, identifying its present and prospective fair share obligations for the Fourth Round as set forth above, and committing to adopting and submitting a Fourth Round Housing Element and Fair Share Plan ("HEFSP") as required by the FHA; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2025, the Hon. Robert Lougy, A.J.S.C., issued an Order Fixing Municipal Obligations for "Present Need" and "Prospective Need" for the <u>Fourth Round</u> in accordance with the obligations as set forth above, and authorizing the Township to proceed with preparation and adoption of its proposed HEFSP; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 52:27D-304.1(f)(2)(a) and Directive #14-24, each municipality must adopt and file as part of its DJ Action a HEFSP, and propose drafts of the appropriate zoning and other ordinances and resolutions to implement its present and prospective obligations, no later than June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Township Planning Board Planner, Kyle + McManus Associates (Elizabeth K. McManus, PP, AICP, LEED AP), has drafted a Fourth Round HEFSP; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:55D-28, the Lawrence Township Planning Board, in its capacity as a Planning Board ("Board"), may prepare and adopt or amend a master plan or component parts thereof, after a public hearing, to guide the use of lands within the municipality in a manner which protects health and safety and promotes the general welfare; and

WHEREAS, upon notice duly provided pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:55D-13, the Township of Lawrence Planning Board (the "Board") held a public hearing on the 2025 <u>Fourth Round HEFSP</u> on June 16, 2025, during which the <u>Fourth Round HEFSP</u> was presented to the Board and public, and opportunity for comments and questions were provided; and

WHEREAS, upon the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board determined that the proposed <u>Fourth Round</u> HEFSP is consistent with the goals and objectives of the Master Plan of the Township, will guide the use of lands in the municipality in a manner which protects public health and safety and promotes the general welfare in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:55D-28, and is designed to achieve the goal of access to affordable housing to meet present and prospective housing needs in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 52:27D-310; and

WHEREAS, the Board now wishes to memorialize its adoption of the proposed <u>Fourth Round</u> HEFSP and request that the Township Council endorse the adopted HEFSP, in accordance with the FHA and Directive #14-24;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lawrence Township Planning Board, as follows:

- 1. The Board hereby approves and adopts the <u>Fourth Round</u> Housing Element and Fair Share Plan annexed hereto as **Exhibit A**;
- 2. The Board Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a copy of the adopted <u>Fourth Round</u> HEFSP and a certified copy of this Resolution to the Township Clerk and Township Council of Lawrence Township, together with this Board's request that the Township Council endorse the adopted <u>Fourth Round</u> HEFSP;
- The Board Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of the adopted <u>Fourth Round</u> HEFSP and a certified copy of this Resolution to the Mercer County Planning Board and New Jersey Office of Planning Advocacy, in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:55D-13.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
